DOGS on a WIRE

Canines leap, balance and tumble to please audiences at 'Zing Zang Zoom' circus

ircus performer
Hans Klose
spends his time
traveling around the
country with 18 members of his extended
family —if you define
his seven fox terriers,
four standard poodles, a
Great Dane, five mixedbreed dogs and an Australian shepherd as
family. He does.

Klose, 35, is the dog trainer for the Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey's "Zing Zang Zoom" tour, which returns to Waco's Extraco Events Center for five shows today through Sunday.

The son of two circus performers, Klose got an early start in the circus, performing as a foot juggler when he was 10. Eventually, he took over his family's dog act at 25. His current "Zing Zang Zoom"

routine features 13 dogs.

Each dog has different abilities, from performing somersaults and leaping from a perch 16 feet above the ground to jumping rope and balancing on a rope on hind legs, a crowd favorite.

"Sometimes it's more challenging to work with humans than it is to work with the dogs," Klose said. "The dogs listen better."


The hardest part of training, he added, is getting new dogs to work together with the older dogs. More than half of the animals with which Klose works come from animal shelters and pounds.

It's all worth it for the dog trainer.

"My favorite part is the relationship you build with them.... You get attached. Once you get a dog and you've spent so much time training them, you've worked with them for so long, I just have to keep them," said Klose, who considers the dogs more like children than coworkers and keeps his retired dogs.

During circus tours, Klose

and his wife travel with their dogs in a recreational vehicle outfitted with an indoor exercise pen. During off-months, the couple share their Sarasota, Fla. home with all 18 dogs.

Joining Klose's trained dogs in this year's "Zing Zang Zoom" are "thrillusionist" David DaVinci and his exotic birds; Catherine and Brett Carden and their dancing Asian elephants; and the Panfilov troupe's cats, whose tricks showcase balance and agility.

Some high flying

The performance will also feature the acrobatics and high-wire motorcycling of the Medeiros Troupe, aerialist Francleib Rodrigues, the metal-bending Kung Fu Kings, the Barons of Balance and their low-wire act, the Salsations' teeterboard act with a Latin flair, the Urias family with their steel globe motorcycling act and the Clowning Caveagna Family's antics.

All ticket-holders may attend the free all-access preshow an hour before show time to learn how to juggle, try on costumes, learn to balance feathers on one end and pick up some new dance moves.

During the pre-show, the circus' animal experts and performers will be present for autographs, photos and questions.
